Bringing food into school from home - allergies

Towards the end of last term, we had a number of children who were celebrating their birthday or the approaching Easter weekend and brought in 'savoury treats' for their class. Whilst this is a lovely gesture and a special way to celebrate an important occasion, most of the 'treats' contained nuts or traces of nuts.

I would like to draw your attention to the guidelines that Mr Hagger included in his letter to parents in February on this subject:

Please do not feel obliged to send treats into school for the children. However, if you would like to do so then our staff will do their best to distribute them as long as you follow the following measures:

- 1. Ask your child's teacher first if there are any children with specific food allergies (you might find it easier to email)
- 2. Only send in commercially bought food that is sealed and in its original packaging so that we can check the ingredients ourselves.
- 3. Do not send in any food that contains nuts (or traces of nuts) as we will not be able to give it out as we are a 'nut free' school.
- 4. Ensure there is enough for the whole class and that treats can be divided easily.
- 5. Bring an alternative for those children who can't eat the 'main' treat.

I am sure you will understand that, as always, it is our policy to make the safety and well-being of all pupils our top priority. Thank you in advance for your support helping those children with food allergies.

Summer Uniform

As from the beginning of the summer term, all children should be wearing summer uniform. Assessment Weeks

During the next two to three weeks, pupils from Year 1 to Year 6 will be taking their annual InCas assessment tests. These are online tests so the pupils will go to the Computing suite. The children will be tested in mental maths, general maths, reading and spelling. The results of these InCas assessments will appear on your child's end of summer term report.
