# Year 6 Leavers' Assembly

Due to our unprecedented circumstances and the need to maintain social distancing and class bubbles, we are not able to hold any of our usual end of Summer Term events. This includes the Year 6 Leavers' assembly to parents that normally takes place on the last Tuesday of term in the school hall.

However, we felt that it would be shame not to celebrate our Year 6 children, many of whom will be leaving Oaklands after many years with us. As a result, we are going to move the event outside to our school field so that we can ensure a level of social distancing between our families, staff and children whilst enjoying watching the children perform.

Our Year 6 classes of 2020 have therefore invited their parents to a unique 'Leavers Assembly Picnic in Sherwood Forest', known by us all as the Oaklands school field, on Tuesday 7 July 2020 from 6.30pm.

We hope to make this an informal but very special event to mark the end of their time at Oaklands within the limits of what is permissible according to government guidelines.

### Year 6 Mini Fete

Year 6 are organising their mini fete for Monday 6 July. Every year, Year 6 pupils choose a couple of charities to raise money for. It is particularly appropriate that they unanimously decided that this year all the money raised should go to the NHS.

Due to current health guidelines, there will be no handling or exchange of money during the Fete between the children. Instead, Reception to Year 5 children have been asked to make a donation of between £2-£5, which must be bought into school on the day of the mini fete in a sealed envelope. Thank you in advance for your support.

The children will be able to access all of the games and activities, such as 'Guess how many sweets are in the jar' or 'Name the Teddy' on the stalls without touching anything. Social distancing will be maintained and each class/'bubble' will visit the Fete separately at their allocated time.

As you will know, term finishes on Thursday 9 July. We will stagger the picking up as follows:

- 12.00pm finish for LK, UK and Reception
- 12.15pm finish time for Y1 & Y2
- 12.30pm finish time for Y3, Y4, Y5 and Y6

<u>Please arrive onto the site no earlier than 5 minutes before your child's slot and leave immediately afterwards.</u> I know that these are nice occasions to stand and chat, but please be mindful of the current pandemic and the government guidelines for schools about large gatherings.

I would like to thank you, the parents, for the support that you have shown the school and your commitment towards helping the education of your children, particularly during the period of home learning.
