Dear Parents

Re: **Year 3 to Year 6 Extracurricular Clubs, Summer Term 1**

As you are aware, since October 2020, it was necessary to put in place a number of changes to our busy extracurricular programme in response to government guidelines regarding extracurricular provision in schools and the need to minimise the risk of multiple year groups needing to self-isolate simultaneously due to a confirmed case of Coronavirus.

In order for us to continue to prioritise keeping our Year 3 to Year 6 children in separate bubbles, we need to continue with similar adaptations to the extracurricular club programme for Summer Term 1. Thank you for your cooperation and adaptability coping with these necessary changes.

For ease of reference and clarification for you, I have listed the attendance arrangements for Summer Term 1 below:

- **Construction Club, Mondays**

Monday 26 April	- Year 1 only to attend
Monday 10 May	- Year 1 only to attend
Monday 17 May	- Year 2 only to attend
Monday 24 May	- Year 3 only to attend

- **Mathmania, Mondays**

As Y3-Y6 children only received 2 sessions last term, the four Monday sessions of Summer Term 1 will be allocated as follows:

Monday 26 April	- Year 3 to Y6 only to attend
Monday 10 May	- Year 3 to Y6 only to attend
Monday 17 May	- Year 1 only to attend
Monday 24 May	- Year 2 only to attend

The sessions in Summer Term 2 will be divided up between Year 1 and Year 2.

- **Cricket, Mondays**

As this club is held outdoors and the pupils in **Year 5 and Year 6** can work in 2 bubbles, this club will take place as normal.

- **Strategy Board Games, Tuesdays**

Year 3 to Year 5 children will be able to attend Strategy Board Games, if parents are happy for them to do so, as the small number of children who attend each session can be spread out appropriately in Y3C classroom.

- **Homework Club, Tuesdays and Thursdays**

Year 3 to Year 6 children will be able to continue to attend Homework Club, if parents are happy for them to do so, as the small number of children who attend each session can be spread out appropriately in Y6C classroom.

- **Dance, Tuesdays**
Year 3 and Year 4 children will be able to continue to attend Dance Club, if parents are happy for them to do so, as the small number of children who attend from Year 2 to Year 4, can be divided up into three areas within the school hall to work during the session.
- **Basketball, Tuesdays**
As this club is held outdoors and the boys in Year 5 and Year 6 can work in 2 bubbles, this club will take place as normal.
- **Karate, Wednesdays**
Pupils in Year 3 and Year 5 will be able to continue to attend Karate Club for Summer Term 1.
- **Speech and Drama, Wednesdays**
Pupils in Year 4 and Year 5 will be able to continue to attend Speech and Drama Club for Summer Term 1.
- **Art, Thursdays**
Year 3 and Year 4 pupils will be able to continue to attend Art Club as there are only a very small number of children who attend each week and they can be spaced out appropriately in the classroom.
- **Computing, Thursdays**
Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6 pupils will be able to continue to attend Computing Club during Summer Term 1 as there are only a small number of children who attend each week.

- **Athletics, Fridays**


Friday 23 April	- Year 5 only to attend
