Re: May 2021 Headmistress's Letter

It is such a pleasure to be able to write a Head's letter that will include invitations to parents to attend some forthcoming events on the school site for the first time in over a year. Class Photographs

'Sharing Experience'

During this half-term, we normally timetable a series of 'Drop-in' sessions for each of the KS1 and KS2 classes which take place first thing in the morning, 8.30-8.50am.

The main aim of the 'Drop-in' session is to give your child the opportunity to show you some of their work books and to explain what they have been doing and achieving. As you will appreciate, we have been unable to facilitate these sessions.

Instead, children in Y1 to Y6 have, at regular intervals, been bringing home one of their workbooks to share their classwork with you. Thank you for writing such positive comments on the stickers for your child to read and treasure.

Upper Kindergarten and Reception have also enjoyed joining in with this new venture by taking home their Topic workbooks to share with their parents over a weekend.

InCas Assessments

From Monday 17 May to Wednesday 26 May, pupils from Year 1 to Year 6 will be taking their annual InCas assessment tests. These are online tests so the pupils will go to the Computing suite. The children will be tested in mental maths, general maths, reading and spelling. The results of these InCas assessments will appear on your child's end of summer term report.

'Pupil Spotlight Feature'

The Oak-Tree Marketing department has initiated a new 'pupil spotlight feature' that will appear on our website and social channels.

Parking Reminder

As you are aware, we regularly send out letters about parking in the vicinity of the school. Over the last few months, I have received an increasing number of emails and calls from residents in Albion Hill.

I would like to take this opportunity to repeat my main requests made in my last parking letter on 11 May 2021:

- Do not park across, or obstruct in any way, the driveways of our neighbours when dropping or collecting your children.
- Consider the safety of all of our children when parking.
- Refrain from using abusive language towards residents and other drivers.
- Use our internal car park in Warren Hill as much as possible.

It has been useful to receive feedback from some parents in response to my letter. One of the main observations shared with me is the lack of spaces available for cars at the 3.15pm and 3.30pm collection times. Could I please ask parents of children in the Lower/Upper Kindergartens and Reception who use the car park for their 3pm pick up time to leave the school site as quickly as possible to free up more spaces in the car park.

Please note that the grass areas in the car park should not be used as 'play areas' for the children at the end of the school day, especially as parents of older children are currently using the grass to park on at peak times.

Year 6 Activity Week

In their final year at Oaklands, Year 6 pupils have historically enjoyed a 5-day residential activity week at a PGL Centre, usually during the first half of the summer term. Unfortunately, we have been unable to facilitate this trip due to the Covid-19 restrictions.

We are, however, determined to provide the children with a memorable outdoor-based activity experience before they leave Oaklands. To fulfil this aim, from Monday 28 June to Friday 2 July, Year 6 pupils will be participating in a fun-filled Activity Week based on our second field, with visits to local venues during the week.

Each day will run from 8.30am to approximately 4.30pm. Tents will be erected on the second field so the children can sit and chat with their friends as they would if they were in their rooms at PGL. Visits to the Wild Forest Obstacle Course at Brentwood, Loughton Cricket Club, The Avenue Tennis Club, Loughton and the Lee Valley Centre have been organised.

The children will also be involved in numerous team building activities such as Robot Wars, Splash, Overflow, Photo Booth Challenge and volleyball and basketball championships. On the last day, we are planning a camp fire with an outdoor disco and pizza takeaway!

I am sure that the children will have a fantastic week with their teachers; let's hope the sun shines for them too!

Swimming

Since our return to school after the Easter holidays, pupils in Year 3 and Year 6 have really enjoyed their weekly swimming lessons with Mrs Stringer, our swimming coach, and Mr Paine.

After half term, Year 4 and Year 6 will be going swimming on Wednesdays until the end of the Summer Term.
