Re: Headmistress's Letter

It seems incredible that this is my final Headmistress's letter for 2021. I am amazed at how fast the Autumn Term has flown by. Besides all the hard work by the children and the staff, this half term has been full of exciting events and performances, and there are still a few events to look forward to.

Oaklands welcomed many new children into the school in September and I am so happy to see how well they have done in their first term. Having read through many of the latest set of school reports, there is much to celebrate in pupils' achievements both inside and outside the classroom, and many encouraging comments about the ongoing personal development of the children.

We have competed in a range of sporting events or competitions where our pupils have shown good sportsmanship and dedication in their victories and in their defeats. Our Year 4 to Year 6 swimmers competed in the ISA LN Swimming Gala on 17 November and performed brilliantly, particularly those pupils in Year 4 who returned with a collection of medals for both individual and team events. Year 5 pupils worked hard during their Indoor Athletics competition against Daiglen School last week as did Year 5/6 Tag Rugby team at the WESSP Tournament and the Y6 pupils at the ISA Indoor Athletics Competition. Congratulations to all the teams and Mr Paine!

Pupils continue to be successful in Art competitions. We were awarded two second places and three third places in different categories of the ISA London North competition in October. We hope to receive the results of the local Loughton Town Council Christmas card competition before the end of term.

The Early Years department has been particularly busy. Lower Kindergarten performed for the first time for their parents on Thursday 11 November. They sang beautifully with the help of the Lower Kindergarten staff and Mrs Rathbone. We enjoyed a highly original performance by the Reception children of their Christmas Show on Thursday 18 and Friday 19 November, which included some amazing singing and dancing, closely followed by Upper Kindergarten entertaining their parents with their Nativity Play, which was simply delightful. Thank you to all the staff who helped prepare the children for these performances.

The London Book Project

This charity collects donations of new and gently used children's books and gives them to targeted schools and organisations. Their aim is for all children to have the opportunity to choose, take home and keep their own books and to develop a love of reading.

Some of you may recall that we supported this charity two years ago. Unfortunately, the Covid pandemic prevented us from helping them last Christmas/New Year so I am very keen to re-connect the school and the children with the work of this local London charity during 2022.

I am in the process of organising a representative from the London Book Project to visit Oaklands in January 2022 to deliver an assembly to the children. From Wednesday 12 January to Wednesday 19 January, we would like the children to bring into school any books they no longer enjoy reading or are now too young for them. Christmas is an ideal time for a sort out so I am hoping we can collect a healthy collection of books to pass to the charity. Parking reminder

Unfortunately, during the last few weeks, we have again been affected by different companies deciding to dig up parts of Albion Hill. Thank you to those of you who have adapted your arrival and collection routine to the closure of Albion Hill and are now parking elsewhere on the surrounding roads or in fact, are now using the school car park. I am however, still receiving communications from a number of residents about their driveways being blocked, parents sitting in cars, with their engines running, waiting on yellow lines or the zig zag lines whilst someone delivers their child/children into school and parents turning their cars around which involve mounting the pavement, causing a potential danger to children and parents walking to school.

I would again like to take this opportunity to repeat our request that parents do not park across, or obstruct in anyway, the driveways of our neighbours when dropping or collecting their children, to consider the safety of our children when parking and manoeuvring, particularly in Albion Hill, and to use the car park as much as possible.
