# Re: February 2022 Headmistress's Letter

Our Year 6 children in particular have been working extremely hard throughout January sitting all their challenging entrance examinations for various senior independent schools. They have all continued to act as role models to the younger children of the school despite the pressure of the examinations. They are a credit to Oaklands and to you, their parents, and we are very proud of them. I am sure that the Year 6 children and their parents are currently enjoying the well-deserved luxury of 'no homework' until after half term.

Throughout this half term, I have been particularly impressed by the enthusiasm all the children consistently show in their learning. On my weekly tours with prospective parents around the school site, many comments are made about the children's self-confidence, and the happy and positive working atmosphere that they see in the classrooms. # **Coffee Mornings**

Our annual cycle of coffee mornings will be completed by the half term holiday. Thank you to those of you who were available to come along to your year group coffee morning. As always, we value your comments, suggestions and thoughts on the education we provide. It is pleasing to hear that the children are happy in their learning and continue to thrive and make progress.

# **Curriculum Information to parents**

During a number of the coffee mornings held this academic year, some parents asked if they could receive additional weekly information about the Maths and English topics being taught each week to their children.

In response to this request, parents in Year 1 to Year 6 have started to receive a weekly Friday email via the portal providing details of the Maths and English areas of learning being taught in the forthcoming week. I hope you will find this helpful in your supportive role with homework tasks.

## Covid-19

We are pleased that there has been a relatively small number of children who have tested positive for Covid-19 this half term and who have had to self-isolate at home in line with the guidance.

May I extend a special thank-you to those parents who were asked to conduct a LFT with their child (close contact) every morning for 7 days following one of these positive Covid results. This procedure, together with everyone routinely testing twice a week, is helping to keep the school community as safe as possible.

# **Parking reminder**

As you are aware, we regularly send out letters about 'Parking'. I would like to take this opportunity to repeat our request that parents do not park across, or obstruct in anyway, the driveways of our neighbours when dropping or collecting their children, to consider the safety of our children when parking and to use the car park as much as possible.

## **Medical matters**

I would like to reiterate to parents that all pupils should be kept off school for at least 48 hours following a sickness or diarrhoea bug. Also, if they have started a course of antibiotics they should also be kept off school for the first 24 hours whilst taking the medication. This is to contain the spread of infection as far as possible. Likewise, if your child is taken ill at school, you will be asked to collect them immediately. Thank you for your cooperation in doing this.

## PSHE Scheme of Work, Reception to Year 6

After the February half term, the children will be exploring, at an age appropriate level, the topic of 'Healthy Me' which includes:

- What is personal hygiene?
- Understanding the importance of healthy eating
- Maintaining an active lifestyle
- Appreciating why they must get enough rest and sleep
- Safety education road safety; on and off-line safety
- How to manage risk
- Looking after one's mental health
- Making healthier choices
- Having respect for myself
- Understanding the dangers of certain substances alcohol, medicines, tobacco

The children will be introduced to the topic during the first assembly they attend after half term. Firstly, a slide of a car will be shown and the children will be asked to consider what is needed to keep the car 'healthy' and to make it go. Once the suggestions of using the right fuel, having periods of rest and the need to regularly use, clean and maintain the car have been provided, their next challenge will be to identify the link between how a car keeps working to our ways of keeping healthy.

Throughout the topic, the children will be encouraged to identify and make 'healthier choices' to their lifestyles.
