Staffing

At the end of a school year we sometimes have to say goodbye to a few members of staff. We wish her every success and happiness in the next stage of her career.

Resources

Although most equipment is provided by the school, we ask parents of pupils in Year 3 to Year 6 to provide a small plain pencil case for their children to bring into school with the following:

Pencil case
Lead pencils, rubber and sharpener
Coloured pencils

Pair of compasses (Year 5 and Year 6 only)
Protractor/angle measurer (Year 5 and Year 6 only)
Blue Frixion writing pen (following the Pen Licence award)

The blue Frixion writing pens can be purchased from WH Smith, Ryman or Amazon. Please do not send anything other than the above, particularly felt tip pens, ink erasers or correction fluids. Please ensure that all equipment is named. Thank you.

Start of the School Day in September

Please note that the school doors will continue to open at **8.25am** from the beginning of the Autumn Term. This provides a time frame of twenty minutes for all the children to arrive. Registration will take place at 8.45am. If you arrive after 8.45am, please go to the school office to sign in your child. A member of the office team will then take your child to their classroom.

Many of the children will be using a different entrance to the school building to access their new classroom. There will be clear signage and additional members of staff available to help you to locate the correct door. Further details will be included in the September Head's letter.

We will be continuing with our current practice of requesting parents to say goodbye to their child outside the school building. Only the children should enter the buildings to go to their classrooms. We will be inviting parents into the classrooms for our usual programme of Drop-in sessions during the first half of the Autumn Term.

PE Kit

After the success of having the children come to school in their PE kits on days when PE is on the timetable, we have decided to continue this arrangement in September. When we start the new academic year, children should come to school in their PE kits and stay in their PE kits on the days they have PE, unless there is a special event taking place during the day such as open mornings or school photographs, when parents will be advised in advance.

This is not the case for extra-curricular clubs. Children need to wear their full school uniform and change into PE kits after school on the days when they have a sports club.

End of Term

Just a reminder that the last day of term is Wednesday 6 July. Pick-up times for the final day are as follows:

- 12.00pm finish for Lower Kindergarten, Upper Kindergarten and Reception
- 12.15pm finish time for Year 1 and Year 2
- 12.30pm finish time for Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6

First Day of Term

Staff will return to school on Thursday 1 September for two training days. **The children return to school on Monday 5 September.** The doors will open as usual at 8:25 am for the children to go to their classrooms and begin their morning activities.

The Oak-Tree Firework Display is booked for Sunday 13 November 2022. Please put the date in your diaries and join us for this enjoyable family event. Mr Hagger will be writing to parents in September with further details.

Oak-Tree Ball 2023
